2) Fellow's Educational and Training Plan

- a) Request a **current OFFICIAL transcript** to be sent to APS Education Office. APS staff will upload it into your online application. Please check back to make sure we have received it. You will be able to see when the transcript is uploaded.
- b) **Advisor/Program Director Contact Information**
Include Advisor's/Program Director's name and title, department, institution, telephone and email address
- c) **Changes to Your Training/Research Plan** (To be completed by **APPLICANT**)
Describe progress and any changes to Training/Research Plan. **Please be complete as possible**, including classwork, publications, presentations, and awards.

3) Training Environment

- a) **Advisor's/Program Director's updated biographical sketch** (NIH-style, **NOT CV**)
- b) **Advisor's letter**
The letter should provide an assessment of the fellow's progress and the likelihood that the fellow will successfully complete the program of study.
- c) **Research training environment changes**
Describe any changes in the training/research environment for the fellow.
- d) **List of Applicant's Other Pending and Current Fellowship Awards/Other Support**
Include Source/Agency and Award Amount for each (if none, specify "none")
