

Postdoctoral Fellow, Cedars-Sinai Medical Center Heart Institute

Under the guidance of the Director of the Barbra Streisand Women's Heart Center (Dr. C. Noel Bairey Merz) at the Cedars-Sinai Heart Institute, the candidate will focus on a funded project to study the relationship between coronary microvascular dysfunction and left ventricular diastolic dysfunction in women with ischemic heart disease. Candidates should have the following attributes: 1) a strong background in integrative (human) physiology, 2) good communication skills (written/spoken English), 3) an excellent academic track record, 4) previous research experience working with human volunteers and/or patients, and 5) be creative, self-motivated and a team player. A doctorate (Ph.D., M.D.) in an area broadly related to the areas of integrative physiology, and cardiac research is required. Background in cardiac imaging preferred.

Applications will be accepted until the position is filled. Funding is secured for 3 years. Salary will be commensurate with Cedars-Sinai policies.
