



Research Scientist

The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center's Department of Internal Medicine and the Dorothy M. Davis Heart and Lung Research Institute is seeking a Research Scientist to conceptualize, design, and implement cardiovascular research involving pre-clinical and translational models of heart disease in a state-of-the-art research facility as part of a multi-NIH grant research program.

The Research Scientist duties include but are not limited to implementing, designing and directing experimental surgical techniques involving pre-clinical models of heart failure and gene delivery, hemodynamic monitoring using invasive, catheter-based, and non-invasive echocardiographic measurements, experimental ex vivo cardiac preparations, data collection, analysis and interpretation, and presentation of data and research findings in oral and written format.

To be considered, candidates must possess a PhD degree; extensive experience in a biological/health science research capacity; demonstrated ability to be a competent and productive researcher as evidenced by peer-reviewed publication record, citation of research by others, presentations to scientific organizations and contributions to the research field; knowledge of sophisticated research techniques in cardiovascular science; and survival surgery and/or animal experimentation experience. The selected candidate must successfully complete a background check and may be requested to complete a pre-employment physical including a drug screen.

The hiring salary range is \$50,000 - \$72,000. The offered salary will be commensurate with the selected candidate's experience.
