

TIPS ON WRITING A SUCCESSFUL ABSTRACT:

Start with a clearly stated hypothesis or aim.
Provide a brief summary of the methods used in the study.
Include sufficient detail about methods that are not in common use.
Describe the pertinent results.
Include quantitative data and statistical comparisons wherever possible.
Make a conclusion that is based on the data presented.
Finish with the significance of the results to the field of study.
