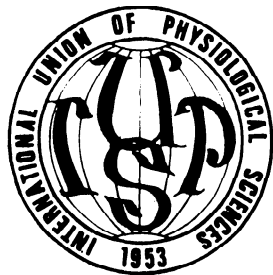
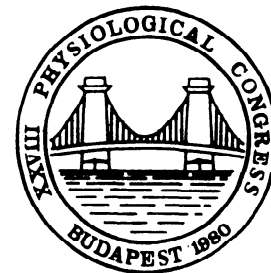


XXVIII INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF PHYSIOLOGICAL SCIENCES

Satellite symposia will be organized in Hungary and in neighbouring countries before and after the Congress.

International exhibition of biomedical laboratory equipments and materials, as well as of scientific publications will be organized.

Language. Each Member may use the language of his choice. However, since no simultaneous translation will be provided, authors are encouraged to choose a language reaching the largest possible audience.

B) GENERAL INFORMATION

a) **Congress venue.** The Congress will be held at the Budapest International Fair and Exhibition Division, Congress Center.

b) **Preliminary registration.** Please complete and return the attached Preliminary Registration Card not later than October 31, 1978 to make sure that you will receive the 2nd Announcement.

c) **Expected registration fees** (in Hungarian Forints):

The registration fee covers the expenses of the printed Program, the Volumes of Abstracts, the Get Together Party, Congress Reception and the costs of tickets for local transportation.

d) **Financial aid.** A limited number of grants will be available mostly for young physiologists. The Grant Application Form will be included in the 2nd Announcement.

e) **Wallace O. Fenn Fund.** The income from the fund is to be used as a Triennial Prize awarded for the most promising abstract of a free communication submitted by a scientist of 35 years of age or younger. Further information will be provided in the 2nd Announcement.
